Skills and attributes

- Flexible and proactive approach: we have a worldwide audience and group of stakeholders so there will be a requirement to occasionally work outside of traditional working hours;
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills including the ability to provide calm assessment, explain things simply and fix things quickly when under pressure. Working within a live broadcast can mean that any issues that arise can create a high-stress situation for the group who needs a quick solution;
- A diplomatic team-player who is comfortable dealing with all levels of staff within the organisation;
- Positive, proactive manner, ability to use own initiative, and willingness to accept responsibility;
- Able to plan, organise and prioritise time effectively and to be proactive in seeking guidance when appropriate.
