Aims of this agenda topic

- We are proposing to implement Taxonomy Packages 1.0 (TP 1.0) for the annual IFRS Taxonomy 2016
 - subject to TP 1.0 being at Recommendation stage by 21st of March 2016
- We think that implementing TP 1.0 will help users of the IFRS Taxonomy:
 - to understand better the content of a specific taxonomy release (what is included);
 - with automated identification of entry points by software tools;
 - by allowing software tools to build their repositories in a more consistent way based on information provided within the TP 1.0 specification.

Taxonomy package description	The annual IFRS Taxonomy 2016 is the XBRL (eXtensible Business Reporting Language) representation of the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), including International Accounting Standards (IAS), Interpretations, and the IFRS for SMEs (Small and Medium-sized Entities), as issued by the IASB.
