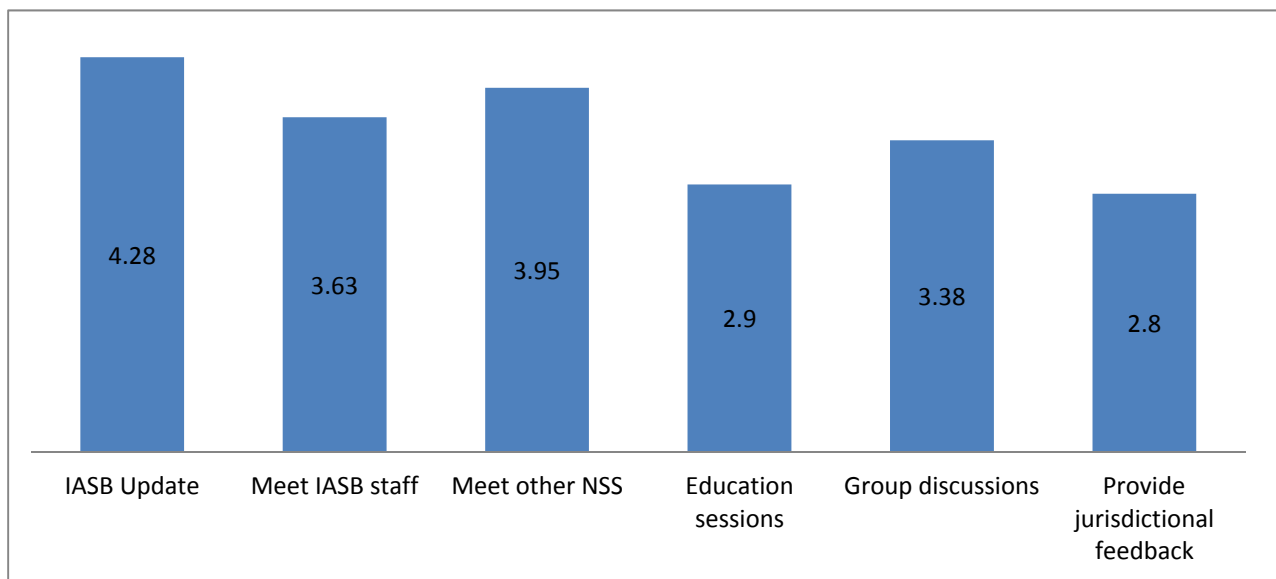

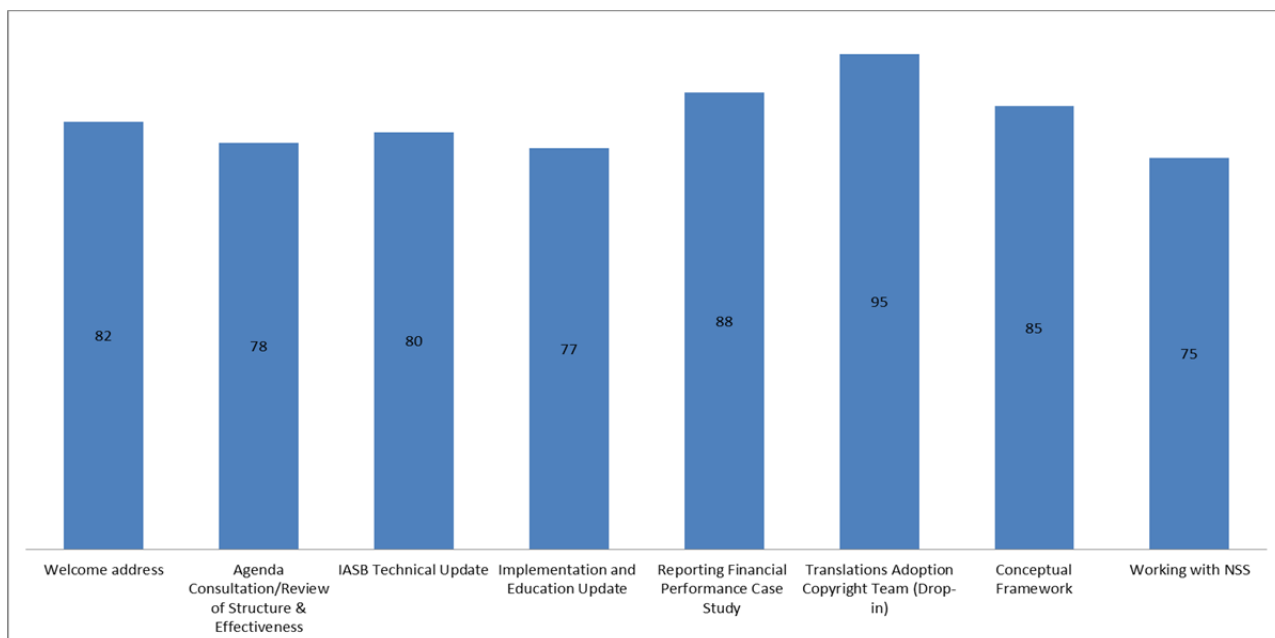

NSS were asked to select the reasons for attending the conference using a scale of 1-6.

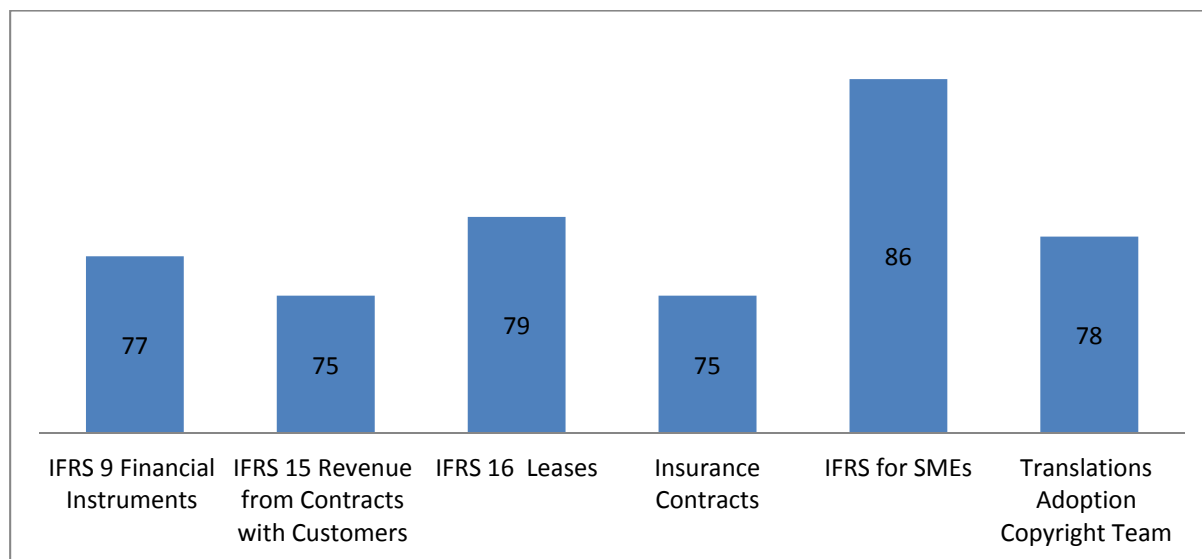
Chart 2: Participants assessment of the content of the main sessions



NSS were asked to rate the overall percentage satisfaction of the sessions held at the conference.

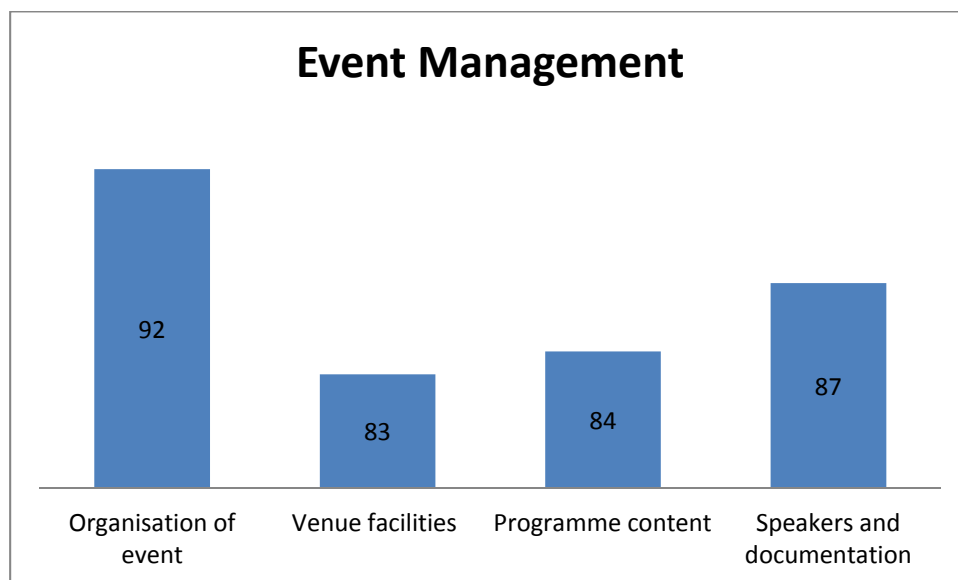
