The Emerging Economies Group (EEG) of the International Accounting Standards Board (Board) held its 19th bi-annual meeting by video conference from 11 to 12 May 2020.

Darrel Scott presided over the meeting discussions.

The meeting provides a platform for discussing specific accounting issues from emerging economies' perspectives, which are helpful in supporting the IFRS Foundation's mission to develop IFRS Standards that bring transparency, accountability and efficiency to financial markets around the world.

The delegates expressed appreciation for China's efforts in assisting the operation of the EEG liaison office.
