WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

The FSA Credential combines two exams to assess a candidate's knowledge of the concepts and skills necessary to analyse sustainability-related financial information.

Level I: Principles

- understand the critical context for today's sustainability disclosure regulations, including understanding the role of standard-setters, regulators and data providers;
- 2) become acquainted with the ISSB Standards and gain a deep understanding of the concepts that underpin them; and
- 3) learn how material sustainability information
 —both cross-industry and industry-specific
 —can inform corporate strategies and investor decisions.

Level II: Practices

- identify the sustainability-related risks and opportunities that affect a company's financial position, performance and prospects;
- 2) normalise sustainability data for effective fundamental, comparative and industry analysis; and
- connect sustainability information to a company's revenue, expenses, assets, liabilities and cost of capital, and apply it to valuation models
